XXXVII International children's team tournament draughts-100 for the cup "Golden checker"

International children's team competition for the cup "Golden checker" conducted on draughts-100 under the auspices of the World Federation of Draughts (FMJD) in the framework of joint activities of the national federations.

1. Goals and objectives

Cup "Golden checker" held for:

- promotion and continuity of draughts games on boards 8x8 and 10x10 among schoolchildren cadet age
- strengthening of friendly relations between young draughts players from different countries,
- growth of sports skill of young draughts players

2. Time and place

Competition will be held from 4 to 9 January 2017 in the town of ALANTA, Molėtų raj (Lithuania~100 km from Vilnius,) Adress: Technikumo 2, Naujasodžio km. Alantos sen. Moletu raj.

3. Governance of competition

The competition is organized by Lithuanian draughts federation

Directly holds competitions jury. Chief judge – Vitas Labutis

4. Calendar of competitions

January 4 - the arrival of teams of up to 15 hours. Personally-team blitz tournament on boards 10x10 - 17.00 hours

January 5 — opening, 1-3 rounds, small sport games.

January 6 — 4-5 rounds, small sport games, conference for coaches.

January 7 — 6-7 rounds, draughts board race (according to the draughts: 10x10), Ball.

January 8 — 8-9 rounds, awarding, closing.

January 9 — team departue

The calendar can be changes except for the timing of arrival and departure instructions.

5. Competitors

Team members - 7 persons: 3 boys and one girl in 2002 birth and younger, two reserve players, the coach - representative. Participants must have sport clothes and shoes.

6. Terms

Competitions are held according to the rules FMJD. System of competition and time control determines the assembly of judges, depending on the number of participating teams. Time control in the blitz tournament - every 5 minutes+ 3sek. for

the whole game and in drafts relay - 7 minutes+ 5 sek.

7. The winners

Recreational teams are determined by the highest number of team points ("big points").

In case of equality of points between two or more teams, place determined by the ratio command, then the "small points". Personal space on the boards in case of equality of points determined at the round-robin tournament in the system of coefficients Shmul'yan, under a system of sampling the lot - according to the points competitors.

8. Rewarding

At the opening of the competition organizers announce the rest of the awards.

9 Reception terms
